NOTES:

1. EACH COURSE CAN ONLY BE USED ONCE TO SATISFY A CATEGORY. Ex. Drama 2206 can be used for optional language arts or fine arts, not both. Receive credit for Applied Music 2206 - choral or iMusic 2206 NOT both.
2. Francais 1202, 2202, 3202 and Core French 1200, 2200, 3200, may be used to satisfy requirements in the Optional Language category credits, OR Other Required Credits (ORC) not both.
3. Four French credits will satisfy the Other Required Credit category instead of doing the normal requirement of 2 different subject areas in the ORC. If French is not done the student must have 4 credits from 2 different subject areas. However, this does not have to be 2 and 2. It can be 3 credits from one area and 1 from another. An example would be as follows: 3 credits from Family studies (Nutrition 2102/ Nutrition 3102/Clothing 1101) and 1 credit from Religion (World Religion 3101).
4. Healthy Living can be used as Family Studies credits in the Other Required Credits category **or** Physical Education credits, not both. When Healthy Living is used as Physical Education credit, HL1200 will count as a category in ORC under family studies allowing 4 credits to be selected in any other discipline (Enterprise, Religion, Technology, or French) to fulfil the ORC category. **\*\*However, If HL1200 is used as an ORC you must choose another subject area other than Family Studies because HL1200 is in the Family Studies ORC category.**
5. NL Studies 2205 can be used to satisfy Canadian Studies or Fine Arts not both.
6. Clothing 1101/Textiles 3104 can be used as Fine Arts or Family studies (ORC) credits, not both.
7. Courses with **(L)** after it are Local Credits. Students can only receive credit for a maximum of 4 Local Credits within the 36 required for graduation.
8. MUN entrance requirements are different than those above. MUN requires **ten** level 3 credits with a combined 70% average as follows: English 3201, Math 3200 or 3201, a 3000 level Science course (Bio/Chem/Physics/E. Systems), World Studies and any two other 3000 level credits.
9. Any excess credit in the other categories will satisfy the Any Subject Area category. For example, if you have 6 Science credits, 4 will be used for graduation requirements in Science while the other 2 can be used to satisfy the Any Subject Area category.
