Notes:

1. Graduation requires at least 20 of the 36 credits be level 2 and level 3. (ie. 2000 and 3000 courses)
2. Graduation requires at least 9 of the 36 credits be level 3. At least five (5) of these credits must be attained in the Newfoundland & Labrador Senior High School Program.
3. Two course categories must be used to satisfy Other Required Courses category except when Healthy Living is used as Physical Education credits. In this case HL1200 will count as a category in Other Required Courses category under family studies allowing 4 credits to be selected in any other ORC discipline (Enterprise, Religion, French, and Technology. Any two French courses will also satisfy ORC graduation requirements.)
