3. No more than 4 local course credits can contribute to the 36 credits to graduate.
4. Two different disciplines must be used (except French or when Healthy Living is used as Physical Education credits – in this case HL1200 will count as a category in ORC under family studies allowing 4 credits to be completed in any other discipline (Enterprise, Religion, Technology) in the ORC category).
