Senior Prom Policy

Eligibility to Attend

- Senior Prom is a school-sponsored activity
- Student must be in a position to graduate which means:
 - must have 22 credits entering Level III or be eligible to receive a school leaving certificate
- We will work with students to make this happen through credit recovery if possible – come see us at the office



Senior Prom Policy

Eligibility to Attend

- Letters will be given to students who are on academic probation based on absenteeism or credits earned by Mr. Druken after February report cards
- Student must be in regular attendance and committed to school to become eligible for prom
 - ie. Unexcused absence must end



Prom Fees

- June Prom Fee Party of four ~ \$320 (tentative based on registration)
- Party of 3 = \$280; Party of 5 = \$360
- 210 eligible students x 4 = 840 people
- Extra tickets are limited due to seating capacity at Glacier (850 seated)
- First priority is step-parents, grand-parents

Prom Information

- Grade 12 Book Return – Students must return textbooks before Prom to get tickets
- School has to replace unreturned books at its cost; there are no government funds to cover this



Glacier Seating Plan

- All students are expected to complete and pass in a table-seating request form to Ms. Sears in **MAY** after tickets are confirmed – parents will be notified of the details later
- Glacier has round tables of 8 or 10; Larger groups will sit at rectangular tables at the end-zone
- Individual seating arrangements will not be finalized until all fees are paid
- No changes in seating will be possible after the seating chart has been posted



Prom Fundraiser

- Recycling – All recyclables have to be dropped off at the Mount Pearl depot on Old Placentia Rd. Amount is **doubled** by MMSB for schools
- Recycling has to be put in the name of the school with student name on it
- Students should **return all their slips at one time to the office**; all deposits will be doubled and credited to the student less a 10% administrative fee
- Any surplus recycling funds will default to the school at the end of the year if not used for other school activities by the student such as school clothing or the yearbook

SAFE GRAD

Parents organize, decorate and supervise this celebration at the Paradise Rotary Youth Centre

- Fee is usually \$50 per graduate (Budget ~ \$10,000 - \$15,000)
- Graduates can bring a date – If date is 19 or older they can sign SafeGrad contract for themselves
- Must be in the Paradise Rotary Youth Centre by 1 am
- If students leave they can't come back
- Parent must sign consent on a contract to let you leave early



Safe Grad Fundraiser

- Based on parent feedback from last year rather than do several small fundraisers and tie up your weekends we will run one fundraiser this year
- Prize Draw on \$10,000 – one winner – **Draw Date is MARCH 13th**
- 250 - \$100 tickets to be sold with a maximum profit of \$15,000
- **If ALL tickets are sold there will be no need to charge students a SafeGrad fee**
- We are asking each graduate to sell at least one ticket to cover the cost
- If you can sell more than one it will help pay for the decorating, food and entertainment for the graduates and their dates at SafeGrad
